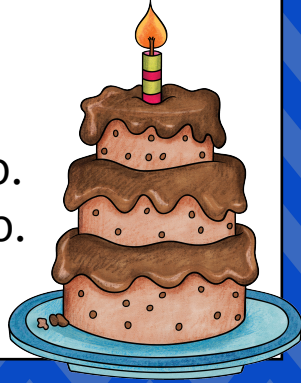

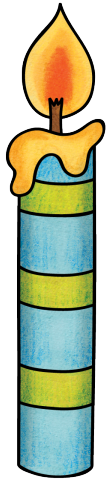
How heavy was the world's largest birthday cake?

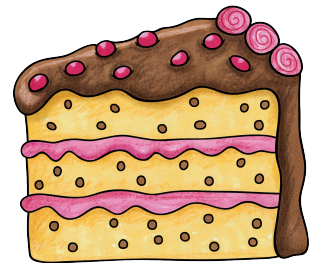

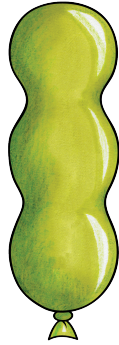

Birthday Trivia Game + Answers

Q: How heavy was the world's largest birthday cake?

Answer: 130,000 lb. The cake was baked and assembled for Las Vegas's centennial celebration in 2005.

Q: What day of the year has the most birthdays?

Answer: September 9th has the most birthdays of any day in the year. In fact, the month of September contains 9 out of the top 10 birthdays in America. (Some sources disagree and say August has the most birthdays.)

Q: In what year was the Happy Birthday song written?

Answer: 1893. The tune came from the song "Good Morning to All." The Happy Birthday words were written by sisters Patty and Mildred Hill, although it is not clear if they wrote the tune as well. The words and tune were published together for the first time in 1912. It is one of the most recognized songs in the English language.

Q: How long did the oldest person in the world live?

Answer: The oldest person on record in the world was Jeanne Calment who passed away in 1997. She lived for 122 years and 164 days.

Q: How many seconds have passed from one birthday to your next birthday?

Answer: 31,536,000. That's a LOT of seconds!

Q: From one birthday to the next, how many miles have you traveled around the sun?

A: 584 million miles!
